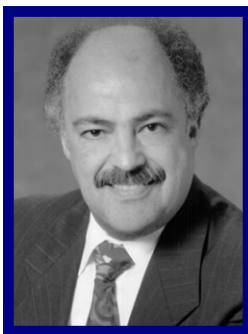
At the last meeting we had a lively and interesting discussion on the fate and use of the Scout House. Everyone had a chance to make their views known and even though there were different points

Next Meeting

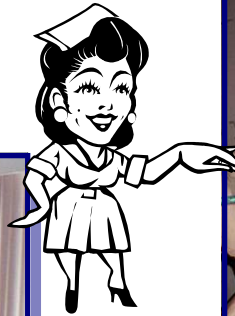
