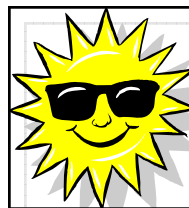

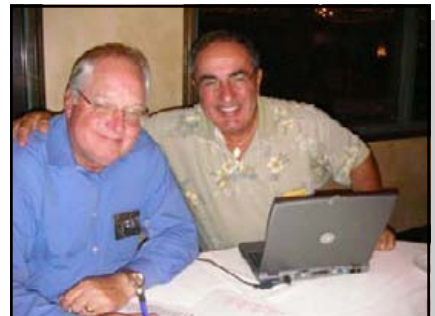

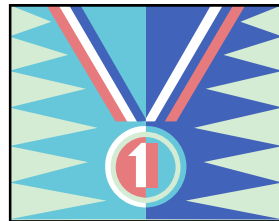
**Millbrae Man & Woman of the Year Dinner**

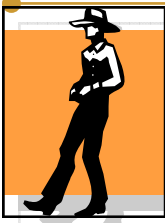

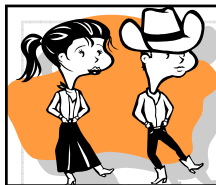
## Our Next Meeting
