## President's Message By LP Randy Sahae

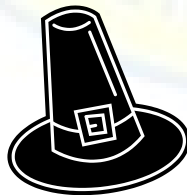
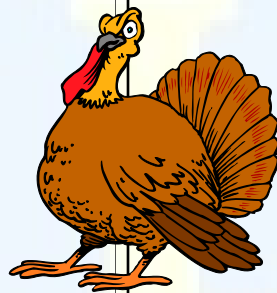
Fellow Lions

pledged to continue renewing this policy during their presidential years (if so elected). This does not affect the general membership except if you are a project chair who has received a donation greater than \$250 in value. Those donating over \$250 need an acknowledgement letter that has specific requirements. I have asked Lion Paul to put the boilerplate letter on our website so that if you are project chair you can download it and modify it as needed.



Did you know that between Baseball, Scouting and Leos the Millbrae Lions are managing programs that affect over 700 youth? Your leaders felt that it behooves us to practice a little bit of due diligence regarding their safety. Scouting already has an extensive set of regulations regarding the safety of the youth in their care. We decided to extend some of those good practices to our Baseball and Leos youth. The attached policy, adopted by the Board of Directors, is our first attempt to put something in place. We probably will amend and improve the policy as time goes by. It is meant to be a starting point rather than a final destination.
