I gobbled up turkey and buttered potatoes, pickles and carrots, beans and tomatoes.

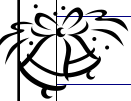
I felt myself swelling so plump and so round, till all of a sudden, I rose off the ground.

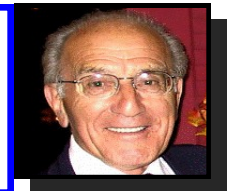
