January-February-March

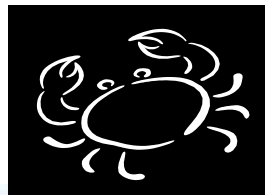

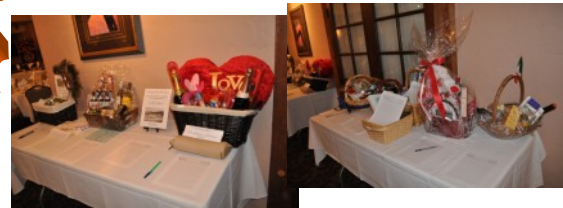
