



MILLBRAE LIONS CLUB YOUTH WEEK

April 17, 2010 through April 23, 2010

THE MILLBRAE LIONS CLUB has begun work on the **50th ANNUAL YOUTH WEEK PROJECT**. We encourage you to participate. An essay contest is one of the many activities offered.

The **RULES** of the **ESSAY CONTEST** are as follows:

1. Essays must have a title.
2. Essays must be 500 words or less (not counting “a, an, the, nor, or, but, yet, so, for, and”), typed *double spaced*, or handwritten *in pen* by the student.
3. **DO NOT SIGN or put your name on the essay.**
4. **On a separate piece of paper, LEGIBLY PRINT** your name, mailing address, phone number, school, English teacher and your grade. Staple this paper behind the essay.
5. **Write your essay on one of the topics listed:**
 - a. Who is your role model and what are his/her qualities that you admire?
 - b. Describe an incident that has changed your life and what you learned from it?
 - c. What are the qualities and benefits of good parenting?
 - d. Describe how and why you would change a part of your school.
 - e. What would you like to see improved in your neighborhood or city and why?
 - f. What are the benefits and applications of taking vocational classes such as home economics, construction, auto shop, photography and others.

NOTE: When using the words of other writers, use quotation marks. Make this essay your own work with references to personal experiences. Use examples to explain your point.

6. **All participants will receive an Award Certificate** from the *Millbrae Lions Club*.
7. Essays will be judged according to relativity to topic, organization, expression of ideas, use of correct punctuation, grammar and neatness.
8. Each school committee will read all essays and select 10 finalists. The ten finalists’ essays from each school will be sent along with all submitted essays to Lion Paul Larson by **Friday, March 19, 2010**. **Winners** will be selected from the essays submitted:
 - Two (2) Winning Essays will be chosen from Grades 4-5
 - Two (2) Winning Essays will be chosen from Grades 6-7-8
 - Two (2) Winning Essays will be chosen from High School
9. **Winners** will be selected by a judging committee from the **TAYLOR MIDDLE SCHOOL FACULTY**.
10. **Winners** will have their pictures in the **EXAMINER’S** special *Millbrae Lions Club Youth Week* section.
11. **Winners** may bring their parents **or** one sponsor (sponsor being a teacher, principal, or clergyman) to the dinner meeting of the Millbrae Lions Club at the **EL RANCHO INN ~ PALM ROOM**, 1100 El Camino Real, Millbrae on Wednesday, April 21st at 7:00 P.M. sharp. The awards will be given during the dinner meeting.
