A Millbrae Lions Club committee will review each submitted nomination and make a final selection based on evaluations in areas including:

- Contributions to Millbrae's youth;
- Character & community standing;
- Youth oriented accomplishments & involvement;
- Reputation in the eyes of Millbrae's youth.

**HOW TO NOMINATE**

Complete a nomination form for each individual that you wish to nominate and return the forms to Mentoring Award Committee Chairman - Lion Paul Larson by Friday, March 19, 2010. Nomination forms should be typewritten OR using additional pages printed via computer. Be complete in your description of why you think the nominee should receive this award. The nominating committee will evaluate each nominee ONLY on the information submitted.
